



OVERVIEW

Hope Abides was founded in 2010 with the goal of providing help and hope orphaned and destitute children in India without regard to gender, religion or caste. Founding Board members Brent and Marie Adams, Suresh Kotha and Jan Polmanteer had no NGO experience to draw upon in creating this little charity; in fact, three of the four Board members had never been to India. What they did have was a deep belief that some of the most vulnerable children in the world were worthy of a helping hand.



Hope Abides was officially incorporated September 13, 2010 and work began to find deserving and trustworthy NGO's with whom we could partner. Major milestones in 2011 included inviting select Indian orphanages to submit applications for grants, performing due a diligence review of information provided, and site visits to all the finalist applicants; a journey that included traveling from the southernmost to the northernmost regions of the country.

By the end of 2011, we had raised over \$25,000 and made our first grants which included replacement of the dangerously unstable roof of a boys' dormitory and the purchase of a buffalo to provide milk for the orphanage's children.

Thanks to the help of volunteers, individual supporters, foundations and corporations, our donation base, our ability to help our children, has shown steady growth. Our individual supporters draw largely, but not exclusively, from California, and come from varied backgrounds - Indian and American, young, old and in-between; low-, mid- and high-incomes, many people of faith, as well as those with more secular views.

In 2019, donations topped over \$100,000 for the first time. In total we have raised over \$678,000* and awarded dozens of grants (totaling over half a million dollars) to help orphanages, schools and other NGO's who serve some the most at-risk children in the world.



* Note this amount reflects gross amounts from our fundraiser, not net; and in-kind (non-cash) contributions and services such as our annual audit.


Your donations have provided thousands of meals for children, laid the foundation of a school now teaching hundreds, repaired crumbling infrastructure, and most importantly paid for the education of numerous children up to, and through, university.

We have further expanded our reach and your generosity by partnering with like-minded non-profits such as For One Another (FOA), Mahaan Aasha Foundation and Little Sun. For example with FOA, we have been able to provide clean water solutions by digging wells, laying pipe or giving ultra-efficient, lo-tech water filters to villages, schools and families. For some villages and families it was their first time ever having regular access to clean water.

We are thankful and proud of our successes. Of course there have been difficulties and setbacks along the way. Our biggest on-going challenge in the U.S. is the raising of funds for children half a world away. Only 6% of giving in the U.S is for international causes. This means before we even approach potential donors, we are already at a disadvantage due to typical giving priorities. This is what makes your support so critical and appreciated.

For all we do accomplish, there is still an enormous need in India. It is our hope and belief that many of the children, as they enter adulthood, will be able to help others thereby amplifying the impact of Hope Abides.

Globally, COVID was one of the dominating issues in 2020; not only from a health perspective, but also its financial ripple effects. Our revenue dropped by approximately 40% from 2019. Children's lives were disrupted with schools closing, and many orphans being returned to extended family to wait out COVID. As 2021 ramps up, we are expecting our partners to be making requests for education related grants. School for many has resumed. This will mean children will need help with tuition, books and more – especially college and university students for whom the costs are relatively prohibitive.



A Report of Hope Abides' Impact on the Children's Home of the Aum Pranava Ashram Trust since 2014/2015

Educational support for the children

The Aum Pranava Ashram Children's Home was founded in 1996 in South India in the State of Tamil Nadu. The married couple V. Visvanathan (Indian) and Edeltraud Englert (Austrian) are the founders of the Children's Home and have been living with the children in a family-like atmosphere since its inception

Hope Abides started supporting the Children's Home in the school year 2014/2015, after a visit of the founders, Mr. and Mrs. Brent and Marie Adams, to the ashram premises.

Initially, Hope Abides helped meet the children's living expenses by providing individual donor support for individual children.

From the school year 2017/18 onwards, Hope Abides started funding the school education for many children of the Children's Home. In the school year

2017/18, Hope Abides contributed more than ₹3 Lakhs (Rs.300,000) to cover the school fees and uniforms for 40 children.


From the academic year 2018/19 onwards, Hope Abides decided to include the educational expenses for Higher Education to their list of substantial contributions to the Aum Pranava Ashram Trust.

Helping children achieve their goal to study at various (local) colleges or vocational institutions is a long-term, academic effort and requires financial back-up from the donor community.

She wanted to become a doctor, but she could not pass the academically rigorous exam for entering a medical college. As promoters of her Higher Studies, we found a Nursing and Paramedical Science College in Tamil Nadu near her mother's home. Hope Abides found a sponsor for her Medical Lab Technology Course, where she is studying her second year successfully. Her father took to heavy drinking with violent

outbreaks of anger. Eventually, he died an early death, leaving his illiterate wife and four children behind without family support. One of Saroja's siblings committed suicide.

Impact of HOPE ABIDES at KESS

KESS is proud to be in partnership with Hope Abides from 2017, helping our mission directly and indirectly. The direct support are the grants received annually since then to the school going poor children especially those infected or affected with HIV/AIDS, cancer and the flood disasters. Funds for tuition, boarding, transportation and educational materials like uniform, school bags, stationery materials, books, study furniture etc were provided to nearly 300 children during this period. Apart from these, Hope has always been highly supportive in linking KESS with other funding agencies which has helped extend our network and find other productive partnerships. Such linkages have helped us provide poor children with educational support and sponsorships, facilitate drinking water provisions such as water wells, tanks, natural pits, water purifiers etc to poor families in drought affected regions and natural disaster relief to various parts of the country, especially in the rural, tribal colonies in primitive conditions.

KESS is ever grateful to Hope Abides and the support received through all the benefactors associated. You have constantly been that great pillar of support from across the world, reflecting that care and hope has no borders nor distance. We can never be thankful enough for your concern to our children, many of whom have progressed academically, psychologically and socially due to this continuous support we have been able to provide as a result of this collaboration. The blessings and prayers of these children and the various families are always with you all. KESS is honoured and greatly blest to be associated with Hope Abides and we pray our partnership continues to make the lives of these families and our world a better place.

Case Studies of Children supported by Hope Abides

1. Riya N.V.

Riya's family's condition was one that everyone sympathized. The only breadwinner of her family-her father died of cancer after a long period of expensive treatment hence pushing the poor family even further into debt and loans without the means or the income to clear them. Riya has a younger brother and sister apart from her mother-a frail lady who isn't quite healthy herself. KESS took upon the care and support of this needy family, especially the education support of Riya and her siblings. The regular support from HOPE Abides really helped since Riya's higher secondary and higher studies required more fees than her school going younger ones. KESS also helped her mother get into a daily wage job and found sponsors to help them restore their house on the verge of collapse. Riya's meritorious admission to the degree course in Web Technology in a reputed College was a great achievement but the fee structure was a great cause of concern and she almost backed out if it weren't for the great support of HOPE Abides which gave KESS the confidence to motivate her further. This academic year where the COVID Pandemic caused great distress to everyone especially students like Riya, the support of HOPE Abides helped KESS to give her a Laptop since her studies required the same for better functioning and studies. Riya and her family together with KESS are extremely thankful to HOPE Abides for the consistent support provided which has helped such poor children like Riya achieve heights they could only previously dream of.

2. Andrea Ann Helena

Andrea studies in Std. 8 from a family that is in an extremely poor financial situation ever since her grandfather had been affected with cancer. All the assets and resources of the family had been spent for his treatment and other supports required to help him throughout the illness but finally he succumbed to it, leaving Andrea's grandmother, parents, little sister and herself at tenderhooks of an unknown future with nothing to call their own. When her father was not capable to hold onto a job due to his heart ailments, it was her elderly grandmother, who helped bring in the day to day ration for the family by managing a nursery sales outlet, supported by KESS. After a long struggle, in the midst of surgeries, medication and ill health, her father could also start a small grocery unit next to their home. Her mother took care of the daily household affairs courageously even when the family often did not have enough for a meal. Andrea knew that she had to give it her all to improve the conditions of her family. The interventions of KESS with the help and support of HOPE Abides has been a great help throughout these years for Andrea by providing study materials, personality development sessions, soft skills, career guidance etc. helping her perform better in her studies. Apart from winning excellent grades in her academics, Andrea also excels in oration, having participated and getting prizes at the district levels on a yearly basis. Her determination is an inspiration to her family members especially her little sister who is also competitively trying her best to score well in all the spheres just like her elder sister. Her family is always obliged to KESS and HOPE Abides, for surely KESS could not have pulled up this child without this full fledged support from HOPE.

KESS is sincerely thankful to HOPE Abides, especially to all its benefactors, volunteers, associates and supporters for reaching across the globe to help our children in distress, whether it is to support their annual academic needs, specific educational requirements, emergency situations like natural disasters or pandemics; HOPE has been most kind to our needs always.

Ratna came to Sphoorti in 2006 when her mother just passed away. She was 9 years old then. Her father is an agricultural laborer and was not in a position to support her studies and pay for her other expenses.

Since she had never been to school, we had to start from scratch. She attended Kindergarten to learn basics. With great efforts from our staff and school teachers, she moved up the Grades and by the time she turned 16, she was able to complete Grade X and Grade XII by 18. Her good academic performance got her admission in Bhavan's Degree College, one of the premier Undergrad Colleges in Hyderabad. Support from Hope Abides and others gave us an opportunity to invest in Higher Education of our children who showed potential.

Ratna completed her Undergrad in 2018. She has since been working in Cognizant Technology Services as an IT Professional. She is not content in stopping there. She wishes to be a Data Scientist in future.

She also wishes to inspire girl children like her to think big and work for their goals.

I can explain the impact of Hope Abides with another example

Ratna has a younger sister Devi who had joined Sphoorti at the same time. She soon lost interest in studies and went back to her father. She did not attend school and was married off when she was 16. By 20 years of age, she has 2 children and is a stay-at-home mother.

Over the last one decade, Sai has grown from a child from an impoverished family into an intelligent and committed student.

He joined Sphoorti in 2011 from a very poor family. His father was sick and unable to work, his mother was working as a temporary worker in a food outlet in a hospital in Hyderabad.

With the help of Hope Abides and our staff, we were able to transform him into a confident student.

After he joined Bhavan's Degree College for his Bachelors' Program in Computer Science, his commitment levels increased further. He joined National Cadet Corps and completed the prestigious Certificate 'C', the final certificate for a Cadet. He is working hard to get into a good IT company. In the future, he wishes to have his own start-up.



In addition to the impact on individual children, Hope Abides has made an impact on our organization too.

Through your contacts, we were able to get sponsors for our building block. Good Works Institute and Guru Krupa helped us because you suggested Sphoorti. Guru Krupa has sponsored 6 rooms so far.

Hope Abides itself contributes through regular scholarship programs.

There are the lot requirement and limited resources.

It has started to provide basic need of food and educational support, which reflects a healthy environment to these children, they learnt the disciplinary way of education. HOPE ABIDES arranged a yearly meet with these kids, which motivated to increase a confidence level with them. The kids represents their skills, how they are developing the more and more knowledge through this platform.

HOPE ABIDES extended the work to providing sponsorship program, individual gift to ranking students, which helps them to establish the more interest of their education. The decisions has been taken to establish a computer library, reading room, dining hall, construction of recreation room etc. for the better quality education for this orphanage.

On the other hand, a huge experiment done by HOPE ABIDES to call the seminar to representatives of Indian Orphanages those are involved in this program, the training workshop held at BHOPAL in 2015, MADHYAPRADESH, INDIA. It's a large size learning lesson to all the participants for this workshop.

The impact of the fund released by HOPE ABIDES USA...

1. The kids get more interest to learn the quality education.
2. The kids also improved the different skills, communication, music and dance and sporting fields in their own interest.

3. Two students gone for Mech. Engineering for their final year 2020. Sandesh and Yogesh are learning their final year of Engineering, if they could not get this platform, both replied that they would found a hard worker to earn the money for their bread-butter.

4. One student completed his Diploma in Tele-Communication diploma for year 2020. Govardhan said, it's a turning point to him, if he couldn't get a support, he not sure what he will be in future.

5. Two kids gone for vocational training, once they finish the course, they will an opportunity to get a job in their field. The two students SANDESH and RITESH get the support to qualify for them for the vocational course.

Food Project : HOPE ABIDES released a grant for grocery, milk, fruit, chicken & eggs which help a physically fit to these kids, otherwise it suffers to reach the local partner's to extend their hand for this program.

Building Project: HOPE ABIDES took the huge decisions to repairing works, construction of dormitories, dining hall which were the needful decisions to sustain this program at this location PUNE, INDIA.

If HOPE ABIDES will never considers these proposals, SASA will have to spend the more time to reach their goal.

MISSION FOR THE RURAL PEOPLE

It is an extreme Joy for me to receive working with Hope Abides.

I do not have the words to express my deep gratitude for Hope Abides supports. Without Hope Abides Nothing here. Hope Abides is doing a huge help in every way of our Mission for the Rural People projects.

Hope Abides are helping 150 children feeding and their education.

We have started a school building construction with Hope Abides Support. Now it is completed with 16 class rooms with ground floor and first floor. Present 300 children are studying in our school.

Nearly 40 children are studied higher grade education (College Education) through the grants help of the Hope Abides.

One of our girls called Saritha, she was completed Doctor of Pharmacy 6 years course through the help of the Hope Abides with 86 % marks.

One of the boys called Gangadhar, He is begging in the road side with his father and unexpectedly they were met Mr. Brent and Mrs Marie Adams in our orphanage in vellatur. They asked him to study so the father was agreed and he left here his son Gangadhar nearly 8 years back. His father was died but this boy is studying now in our orphanage with 10th grade. Now he is sponsoring by Hope Abides.

We have 150 children in our orphanage. But they are all eating out side. They saw the situation of the children when they are eating rains are coming and winds are coming all the dust go into their plates. At that time, we don't have any dining hall for the children, The Hope Abides are supported 4 years back they were supported to a Big Dining Hall and Kitchen Rooms for the children. This very huge and needy help for our children.

The Hope Abides donated a water filters to purify the water and it is helpful for villagers.

Hope Abides are built the water plants in 3 villages. Nearly 800 hundred people are benefitted in these 3 villages through their water plants. And in our school and orphanage children are every day they are drinking pure water from the plants.

Now 6 children are completed nursing courses through the Hope Abides grants. They got jobs in this COVID-19 time. We are over joyed because our children are got the good jobs of Nurses in this pandemic time. It is great blessing to our girls.

Now another girl Joyce Melody is studying MMBS (Doctor course) in Philippines. Now she is completed 2years with support of Hope Abides.

Hope Abides are supported for Boys Dormitory construction. This is also big dream fulfilled by Hope Abides. We have sister orphanage in Moparru. Now the Hope Abides are helping to constructing the dining hall.

Recently we are worried about the school maintenance. So, the Hope Abides are come forwarded to run the school like teachers' salaries, driver salaries and etc... It is unforgettable help by the Hope Abides.

Many are the Hope Abides are doing in our every aspect of our Mission projects. We cannot express our deep gratitude to Hope Abides team and Board Members.
