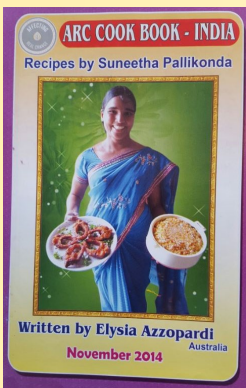

Clean Water for Children

The children of Affecting Real Change Moparru orphanage in Andhra Pradesh are now able to enjoy filtered water direct from a on-site bore well. The filter processes over 13 gallons an hour.



Alex Ralls, director of Affecting Real Change recently wrote "I have to say I am amazed at the difference the filter makes - Raju demonstrated taking some readings of the bore water and filtered water at Moparru, with the filtered water being approximately 40/50 and the bore water being in the 1000's!"

Total cost for the filtration system, bore well, all parts and labor was less than \$1,250. This project was done in partnership with and funding from [For One Another Foundation](#).

Can you Help Rajesh?

Rajesh is 10 years old and in 5th grade. He comes from a tribal community in the Nalgonda district. His father died 7 years ago and his mother works as a sweeper in a company.

He and his sibling still believe that their father is alive and will come back sometime in future. They were brought to Sphoorti Foundation in 2011.
